- Under an agreement between the **Government of India and the World Health Organization, 'WHO Global Centre for Traditional Medicine' (WHO GCTM)** will be established in Jamnagar, Gujarat.
- It will be set up under the Ministry of AYUSH. It will be the **first and only Global Outpost Centre** for Traditional Medicine in the world.
- It aims to make **traditional medicine** useful for global well-being, develop evidence-based research, training and awareness centres, and offer a comprehensive approach to achieving the Sustainable Development Goals.
- A **Joint Task Force (JTF)** has been constituted for its establishment and coordination, execution and monitoring of activities. It is worth mentioning that its establishment was announced on November 13, 2020, on the occasion of **5th Ayurveda Day**.
