- Apart from the mobile app the CJI also launched a new feature in the Supreme Court's official website called 'Indicative Notes', aimed at **providing concise summaries of landmark judgements in an easy-to-understand format.**
- Indicative Notes will serve as a useful resource for media persons and the general public who wish to be better informed about the ruling of the court. The CJI mentioned that **temporary arrangement of live-streaming court proceedings could become permanent** amid COVID-19.
