- Inter-Operable Criminal Justice System (ICJS) is a **national platform for enabling integration of the IT system** used for delivery of Criminal Justice in the country **by five pillars** namely :
 - Police (Crime and Criminal Tracking and Network Systems)
 - e-Forensics for Forensic Labs
 - e-Courts for Courts
 - e-Prosecution for Public Prosecutors
 - e-Prisons for Prisons
- The Central Government has **approved the second phase of ICJS project**, which **will ensure effective and modern policing**. The system is being **built on the principle of 'one data one entry'**.
- The total cost of the project is Rs. 3,375 crore **for the period of 2022-23 to 2025-26**. It will be implemented in collaboration with the states and union territories.
- **National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB) will be responsible for the implementation** of the project in association with National Informatics Center **under the Ministry of Home Affairs**.
