



Montreux Convention

- **The Montreux Convention is a multilateral agreement on the administration of the strait, signed in 1936**, which gives control to Turkey over the Bosphorus and Dardanelles Straits.
- Under this, **Turkey has the right to regulate the transit of naval warships** during the event of war and to block the straits for warships of countries involved in the conflict.
- Turkey can limit the movement of Russian warships between the **Mediterranean Sea and the Black Sea** through two strategic straits under this convention.
- However, countries bordering the **Black Sea have certain privileges** under this convention, which undermine Turkey's traffic control powers.
- The **Bosphorus and Dardanelles Straits** are also called **Turkish Straits** or **Black Sea Straits**. It connects the Aegean Sea and the Black Sea through the **Marmara Sea**. It is the only waterway through which the Black Sea port can be accessed from the Mediterranean Sea.
